Competition Rules and Regulations: Photography Submissions

By submitting your photo, you are granting permission to CAUSE Canada and the Calgary Board of Education to post your submission via the world wide web and redistribute your photo as promotional material through print.

- Photos must be no larger than 8X10 format, high resolution is highly recommended and must be submitted digitally to mmspeight@cbe.ab.ca
- Entries must be original and entirely the work of the entrant
- Entries must not be copies, derivatives or based in any way on other copyrighted or published paintings or photographs.
- The Artist's name, grade, (if applicable) City and Country must be submitted with all entries. Children under the age of 18 will not have their last name posted unless indicated otherwise.

All artists under 18 must have a parent/guardian sign a "consent to publish" form. This form must be submitted with your entry.

- Each artist may submit only one entry and must be accompanied by a reflective summary
- All entries will be juried by April 30, 2007. Winning entrants will be contacted by email at this time.

Creating a Reflective Summary

- All entries must be accompanied by a reflective summary as a separate document. Please include the following things in your summary:
 - Why did you use this *medium* in this project?
 - What does this piece mean to you? What is its title?
 - How this changed how you view the importance of the MDGs?
 - What message do you want to send to the world through this piece?
 - Will you take action or do anything different because of this?
- Are you ready to submit your photography submission? Here's Your Checklist:
 - Have you read the rules and regulations?
 - If you are under 18 have you shared these rules and regulations with your parents?
 - If you are under 18 have your parents filled out the "consent to publish form?" You can download this form from the Many Faces of Poverty Website.
 - If you have, you're ready to submit your photo and your reflective summary. Good Luck!
